NCPC will give participants a well-rounded view of crime prevention as it relates to their communities, cities, states, and countries. There will also be time to network with other professionals in the field to learn what others are doing in crime prevention.

This training is designed for new or fairly new (five years or less) law enforcement personnel, crime prevention practitioners, or those new to crime prevention in their work.
