HELP YOUR KIDS BE SAFE AT SCHOOL

FOLLOW THESE SCHOOL VIOLENCE PREVENTION TIPS FROM McGRUFF:

/ Talk to your children about the dangers of weapons at school.

Explain why it's important to tell an adult if they see a weapon or hear of a weapon or safety threat.

Know your children's friends and where they spend their time.

- If your child has sudden mood or behavior changes, talk to a teacher or medical professional.
 - Be your child's role model of nonviolence.
 - Ask your child's school to adopt an anti-violence program.
