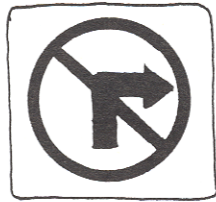


# Being Safe With Signs

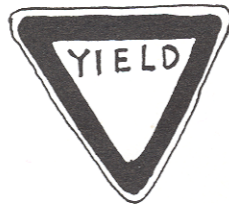
